Statement of Purpose

It is the goal of Leadership Cadiz-Trigg County to develop a source of informed, civic-oriented, volunteer leaders who are interested in helping direct the future of Cadiz and Trigg County.



Leadership Cadiz-Trigg County is a program designed to develop the leadership potential existing in our community. It brings together individuals with diverse backgrounds and experiences, who have demonstrated talent and commitment for leadership.

The program includes:

- One full day in the community each month in various locations throughout the area.
- Opportunities to network with community leaders and other leadership groups.
- Small group discussions.
- Facility tours.
- Extensive program, class, and community related group presentations.
- Community service events.
- Training in leadership skills.
- Completion of a community project (see project requirements below).

The program will:

- Provide a systematic educational program to familiarize participants with the community's opportunities, needs, problems, and resources.
- Establish an effective dialogue and peer-relationship arena among participants and program alumni, as a common ground for present and future communication.
- Provide a rapport among participants and individuals currently in leadership positions within the community.
- Identify individuals who have demonstrated leadership qualities and concern for the community's future.

Selection Criteria

Participation in Leadership Cadiz-Trigg County is a competitive process open to individuals working or living in Trigg County. The Selection Committee will select up to 20 participants who represent a cross-section of the community. Applicants must have the full support of the organization or business they represent in order to commit the time and effort required by the program. It is an honor to be chosen for Leadership Cadiz-Trigg County; therefore, there is an expectation that the individual will remain involved in Cadiz and Trigg County in the future. Selection is based on an application that can be obtained from and returned to the Chamber of Commerce by the published deadline date of **May 1, 2018**.

Pending review by the Selection Committee, all applicants will be notified by June 1, 2018 of their acceptance or non-acceptance. The new class will be announced at the Chamber of Commerce Annual Dinner on **June 26, 2018**. Admission is expected to be highly competitive and those not chosen are encouraged to reapply the following year.

Attendance Requirements

It is an honor to be chosen for Leadership Cadiz-Trigg County and, as such, attendance at every session, community day and activity is mandatory. This also includes the opening retreat, Chamber of Commerce Annual Dinner, and the class project.

If a class member misses a community day for extenuating circumstances, that individual may stay in the class. However, in order to fulfill the graduation requirements, the missed day must be completed during the following class year. If you or your employer is unable to make this commitment, it is not in your best interest to apply.

Tuition

A small tuition fee is charged for the Leadership Cadiz-Trigg County program, which covers all of your meals and instructional materials used throughout the course. The fee is \$250 for Chamber of Commerce members or \$300 for non-members. No refunds will be issued for any reason following the opening retreat. A limited number of partial scholarships or sponsorships may be available for hardship situations.

Class Project

Part of the graduation requirements for Leadership Cadiz-Trigg County is the completion of a class project. Projects must be tangible, completed by the date of graduation (weather permitting), beneficial to the community, and collaboratively developed by the class members.
